ARIZONA & APACHE COUNTY VOTERS MUST PROVIDE ID AT POLLING PLACES FOR ALL ELECTIONS

ST. JOHNS, AZ – February 15, 2006 – All voters will be required to show identification at polling places during the 2006 elections.

“We look forward to the opportunity to educate and to ensure that each elector who casts a ballot is a registered voter of Apache County.” Pew said. “Voters should call my office or the Recorder’s Office to make sure that the photo ID they have matches the voter records.”

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION WITH PHOTOGRAPH, NAME, AND ADDRESS OF THE ELECTOR

- Valid Arizona driver license or Arizona non-operating identification license
- Valid Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification (**with a photo**)
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification
- Any other form of ID with voter’s photo, name & address which election officials determine equally reliable

An identification is "valid" unless it has expired.

REMEMBER A PHOTO ID IS NOT REQUIRED

IF A VOTER DOES NOT HAVE A PHOTO ID WITH NAME AND ADDRESS,

THEY MAY BRING TWO OF THE FOLLOWING ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION WITHOUT A PHOTOGRAPH THAT BEAR THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE ELECTOR:

- Utility bill of the elector that is **dated within ninety days of the date of the election**. A utility bill may be for electric, gas, water, solid waste, sewer, telephone, cellular phone, or cable television
- Bank or credit union statement that is **dated within ninety days of the date of the election**
- Valid Arizona Vehicle Registration
- Indian census card
- Property tax statement of the elector's residence
- Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
- Vehicle insurance card
- Voter Registration Card / Recorder's Certificate
- Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification
- Any other form of ID with voter’s name & address which election officials determine equally reliable

An identification is "valid" unless it has expired.
