**Announcement: The 2019 Real Property Notice of Change will be mailed September 28, 2018.
Deadline to file an appeal is October 23, 2018.**

In accordance with ARS § 42-15105, the Assessor's Office is required to send you a supplemental Notice of Value for property that is valued by the Assessor in the case of new construction, addition to, deletion from, or splits or combinations of assessment parcels and changes in property use during the current valuation year.

If you believe that your property has been improperly valued or classified, you may file a petition with the Apache County Board of Equalization within 25 days of the mail date of the notice.
